Re: Dingo Skid Steer Mini Digger

Being the Contracts Administrator / Team Leader for the Frankston City Services, I have considerable input into the purchase of new plant. In the case of the Dingo Machine and all of the attachments it has become one of the many efficient and more effective items of plant purchased in recent years. This small highly manoeuvrable machine allowed increased productivity giving our Business unit the competitive edge.

After an extensive evaluation and testing process we eventually purchased our Dingo Mini Digger back in 1995 with the view of using it in a multitude of diverse and difficult to access areas.

Apart from the existing hydraulic attachments (jack hammers, pump, chainsaw etc) The additional attachments carried on the purpose built galvanised trailer included at the time of tender were as follows:

- 4 in 1 bucket
- side shift backhoe and buckets
- remote controlled high pressure drain cleaning reel
- heavy duty grip tractor tyres
- night illumination kit and;
- since then added a trencher and a post hole digger to our system.

We are currently reviewing the need to retrofit a forklift attachment for on site works.

The reliability and quality finish of the dingo and its attachments has to been exemplary, with breakdowns virtually non-existent, except of course for scheduled servicing. Dingo mini diggers and their staff are a well established firm that has developed an excellent reputation in all facets of the applications of small construction and maintenance equipment in Local Government.
